

Frank Albert Sinatra was an American singer and film actor.

When Frank was a young man he began to work at radio and there tried to record his first songs. He became an unprecedentedly successful solo artist in the early to mid-1940s. Many critics describes him like a phenomenon, they said that he didn't have outstanding voice, but he was really great and gifted. People called Sinatra "The Voice".

Sinatra released his first album "The voice of Frank Sinatra" in 1946.

His professional career had stalled by the 1950s, but it was reborn in 1954 after he won the Academy Award for Best Supporting Actor for his performance in *From Here to Eternity*. Later he recorded many great things, masterpieces like "My Way", "A man and his Music", "Strangers in the Night", "Jingle Bells"...

Sinatra also forged a successful career as a film actor. As it was already mentioned he got Academy Award for Best Supporting Actor for his performance in "*From Here to Eternity*". He acted in following films:

He also starred in such musicals as "*High Society*", "*Pal Joey*", "*Guys and Dolls*" and "*On the Town*".

After some years of silence in the late 80s Sinatra recorded his track "New York, New York". This song became not only sensational one in his career (for some years the singer was retired), but this song became "The Hymn of New York"!
